Did you know? An exciting <u>new</u> discipline coming to Canberra

There is a new canine discipline coming to Canberra on 1st January 2020; the 'Trick Dog Competition' will become an official ANKC event on that day. It has been developed by members of the Dancing with Dogs discipline & the intention is to encourage handlers to teach their dogs skills & to display behaviours positively.

The competition starts at Starter Class, where the handler picks 6 out of 15 tricks available & once the handler & dog have been trained, they head off to a Competition. Once they have mastered the Starter class then they progress to the Novice class then the Advanced class.

There is a very short timeframe before it becomes an ANKC recognised sport however Dogs ACT will hold an initial information night Tuesday 17th December for Members who think they might be interested. Another will be held in early 2020.

Dogs ACT Agility Titles

The Dogs ACT Agility titles were held over 5/6 October at the ACT Companion Dog Club in Symonston. Judges for the weekend were Ms Simone Tolhurst (WA) & Miss Jenny Taylor (NSW).

The Agility & Jumping Dog of the Year Finals were conducted on Sun morning. These are invitational events for the top 20 dogs determined from results at CT trials in the previous 12 months.

DOGS ACT January shows - Under Cover

There will be two weekends in January for show exhibitors. On Sat 18Jan there will be an evening show & Sun 19Jan two championship shows. The following weekend there will be two shows on each of Sun26 & Mon 27Jan20. Under cover means that while it might be warm the intense heat is eased by the winds that roll through the sheds. Also means that no canopies are required just the dogs & their pens/crates & yourself. Come along & try them out if you haven't been in previous years.

Information for Members re Summernats at EPIC

The set up (or bump-in) of Summernats staff & materials will commence on Mon 16DEC & continue for a week. Dogs ACT Office will be closing on Thu 19DEC (2.30pm) so if Members wish to visit the office 17-19DEC access will be via GATE 2 ONLY, which is the MAIN GATE on Flemington Road. Members will have to drive straight ahead to Dogs ACT & will need to advise gate security that you are visiting our office. You must also EXIT via the same gate.

EPIC wishes to advise that during this period the site will be a construction site with plant & equipment moving about as well as a lot of temporary infrastructure coming to site. Members are to be aware of their surroundings, drive to the road limit (20kph).

Once the Dogs ACT office is closed there is very limited access to EPIC & can only be granted with an accredited pass, which Dogs ACT will not need as the office will be closed.

Dogs ACT office will re-open on Tue 07JAN & once again EPIC will be considered a construction site with the usual dangers & warnings so visitors will need to come through Gate 2 ONLY.

Reminder - Dogs ACT Hot Weather Policy

As the weather heats up it is timely to remind all affiliates & exhibitors that Dogs ACT has a 'Hot & Inclement Weather Policy' for Conformation Shows (Rules & Regs 15).

15.6(a) You are reminded that conformation shows must be cancelled when the BOM forecasts a temperature above 38 degrees or higher at 10am (on the eve) one day prior to an affiliate's advertised event.
