# The following positions will be vacated and open for election in 2020: President, Treasurer and Councillors x 4

Nominations of candidates for election as Council members of the Association must be made in writing, signed by two financial members of the Association and accompanied by the written consent of the candidate (which may be endorsed on the nomination form); and must be delivered to the Administrator of the Association *not less than seven days* before the date fixed for the AGM at which the election is to take place. All candidates shall be financial members of the Association and resident in the Australian Capital Territory prior to nomination.

### **Dunbar Awards**

Owners of eligible dogs must apply to Dogs A.C.T by **31 July** for presentation at the AGM.

### **New Members**

Applications for membership received **after CoB 11 August 2020** will not be processed before the AGM and therefore those applicants will not be eligible to attend and/or vote at the AGM.

### Membership due for Renewal

- Applications for renewal of membership will close as at CoB 25 August 2020 and re-open on 9
   September 2020. This is to facilitate the processing of renewals and the timely preparation of the list of eligible members for the AGM.
- Members whose renewal falls in August 2020 or earlier, that have not lodged and paid for that renewal prior to CoB 25 August 2020 will NOT be eligible to attend or vote at the AGM.
- Members whose renewal falls within September 2020 and later will remain eligible to attend and vote at the AGM.
