- Have not been to a "COVID-affected areas in NSW" within 14 days of the event date

Should it become necessary to restrict the number of entries due to Covid-19 requirements or cancel the trial due to an outbreak of Covid-19, entrants will be advised and refunds provided.

#### TEMPORARY CHANGE TO ANKC AGILITY RULE REGARDING LEADS AND COLLARS

#### Current Rule:

**7.2.1** On the Steward's call of the dog's catalogue number, the Handler will enter the ring via the entry point, with the dog on lead and follow the Steward's and/or Judge's instructions. The lead and harness or head collar must be removed, the collar may be removed and all items handed to a Steward.

The temporary modified Rule:

'7.2.1 On the Steward's call of the dog's catalogue number, the Handler will enter the ring via the entry point, with the dog on lead and follow the Steward's and/or Judge's instructions. The lead will be removed, the collar maybe removed. The Handler will either place the lead/collar in a pocket whilst running the course or wear it on them (e.g. clipped around their waist like a belt). If any of these items fall to the ground or the dog grabs the lead while running the course this will result in a DQ. The lead/collar must be inaudible and if not this will result in a DQ.'
