All Exhibitors must abide by the COVID Safety Plan that has been agreed with the ACT Government to allow these shows to be conducted.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- If you have even mild symptoms, please stay away and get tested.
- Attendees may have their temperature checked on showground entry
- This show is conducted under the By-Laws of the RNCAS.
- Dog exhibitors must enter the grounds via **Old Well Station Road** off the Federal Highway.
- A limited number of DISABLED PARKING SPACES will be available for holders of Government issued permits. Permits must be displayed. Vehicles found to be in breach are liable to be towed away under the provisions of the By-Laws of RNCAS.
- For public health reasons all dogs must be confined to the precincts of the dog section.
- Attendees are encouraged to have downloaded the COVIDsafe app at <https://www.health.gov.au/resources/apps-and-tools/covidsafe-app>
- Entries are open to all states.
- Entries will not be accepted from any current 'Hot Spot' as indicated by NSW Government advice available at <https://www.nsw.gov.au/covid19/latest-news-and-updates> or from a high-risk category as per the current ACT Government advice at <https://www.covid19.act.gov.au/home>
- Online entries only via Easy Dog Entries and will require acceptance of terms laid out in the COVID19 page to enable attendee tracking.
- All persons who are not officials or exhibitors must register their attendance at the office.
- Numbers will be emailed to the exhibitor but can be picked up on the day. It shall be the exhibitor's responsibility to print their own exhibit numbers.
- Only members of the same household can share a gazebo.
- Persons must obey all signs, notices and directions given by the RNCAS whilst at the Showground.
- Persons causing a disturbance or refusing to comply with requests from the RNCAS may be ejected from the Showground.

PHYSICAL DISTANCING

- There shall be no congregating or setting up on pathways or under ring awnings.
- Keep a distance of 1.5 metres between yourself and other people.
- Practise good hygiene at all times.
- No person shall encroach on the Steward's safety zone (1.5 metres)
- Masks are encouraged.
- Hand sanitizer will be available, but exhibitors should bring their own.
- Exhibitors shall enter the ring area via the entrance and depart via the ring exit and maintain physical distancing at all times.
- Ring equipment shall be regularly sanitized during the event.
- Cleaners will regularly maintain hygienic conditions in the restrooms.
- Exhibitors are requested to maintain appropriate hygiene and physical distancing when visiting restrooms.

JUDGING

- The exhibitor shall be responsible for mousing their exhibit.
- The exhibitor will be responsible for adhering to physical distancing requirements when in the ring with other exhibitors and exhibits.
- The Society reserves the right to **substitute Judges or reallocate breeds** from one judge to another should this be necessary.

CAMPING

- Camping facilities are available at the dedicated Exhibition Park in Canberra (EPIC) camping area. **Absolutely no camping is permitted in the car park.** Bookings for camping should be made by calling the EPIC office on 6205 5230.
- **Please note** this is not the usual area allocated for dog show camping and is some distance from the dog rings.
