## Other:

Competitors should submit one entry for each class/element. If you are running two dogs in the same class, you must specify the second handler's name (s13.3) on your entry form. Competitors from the same household will run back-to-back.

All competitors must be registered and a current financial member with their relevant member body.

It is the competitor's responsibility to only enter classes that they are eligible to enter. Refer to s6.1 Titling Classes and s6.2 Progression through the Titling Classes.

Competitors should not train or bring any scent onto the BDOC grounds within two weeks prior to the trial date. Please contact the Trial manager or Secretary if you are travelling and have odour with you on the day so that it can be stored in an appropriate area during the event.

Competitors must park, crate and walk their dogs in designated area only. Please note that competitors not adhering to these rules may be asked to leave the club grounds.

For the safety of all competitors, please ensure that your dog is on lead at all times including leaving your vehicle. The paddocks will be <u>unavailable</u> to free run your dog's due to line of sight.

No bitches on oestrum are permitted at the trial.

The club reserves the right to make any changes that will ensure the smooth conduct of the trial, to substitute or appoint additional judges, to accept or reject entries and to adjust the starting times. Dogs ACT regulations allow contracted judges to compete in trials provided that they don't do so in the classes that they have been contracted to judge.

Note: A contracted Scent Work Judge may compete in Scent Work competition at the same trial for which they are contracted providing they are not competing in the class/s they have been contracted to judge.

Please do not attend the trial if you are unwell or have recently tested positive for COVID, we value our competitors and volunteers.
