Trial entries capped at 70 dogs and limited to one entry per person. If by 16 July there are spaces available, exhibitors might be allowed enter a second dog.

This trial will be using a drag lure and have an enclosed catching pen.

Judging starts: 10.30am

Important additional information (Please read).

- Entries restricted to one entry per person (includes dogs that may be in your name, joint names or registered in someone else's name). This restriction might be lifted if space permits.
- Exhibitors to bring their dogs height card. Dogs without a card will be measured at check-in.
- Exhibitors need to arrange their own handlers and all handlers must be financial members of their state member body. Handlers must be over 16 years of age.
- Exhibitors should enter the name of their handler/helper in showmanager to aid with cataloguing.
- All dogs will run in the first round. Dogs that do not complete the course, will not be eligible to compete in the second round.
- Bitches in season are not allowed on the club grounds.
- The organisers reserve the right to vet any dog if it deems necessary.
- The organisers reserve the right to make any changes to ensure the smooth conduct of the trial.
- The organisers reserve the right to accept or reject entries.
