Dummies can be provided or bring your own that your dog is ALREADY familiar with. The idea of this unofficial class is to introduce you and your dog to the sport of RATG and provide you with some help and advice. Your dog should already have basic on lead heeling skills, a recall and basic retrieving skills or keen retrieving desire.
