Venue: Companion Dog Club Grounds, Narrabundah Lane, Symonston, ACT

Class: 100m Sprint.

Ballot closes 09.00am Friday 11 April 2025

Entry fee: \$20.00 (includes a \$2 equipment fundraising levy).

Online entries only, via Showmanager



Trial A (restricted) – entries capped at 50 dogs, restricted to people living within the area identified in the attached map (see below in additional information) and limited to two entries per person (showmanager profile)

Trial B - entries capped at 50 dogs and limited to two entries per person (showmanager profile)

Judge: Liz Hindley (ACT)

Lure Drivers: Trial A – Helen Mosslar (ACT) Trial B – Belinda Mitchell (NSW)

These trials will be using a continuous lure and have an enclosed catching pen.

Check-in: 8.00 to 8.45am. Anyone not checked in will be marked absent.

Measuring Dogs: 8.00 to 8.45am. Owners will need to fill in the height card before presenting the dog for measurement. Blank height cards will be available on the day.

Vetting: There will be no vetting at check-in, but organisers reserve the right to vet any dog if it deems necessary.

Judging starts: 9.15am

Run Order: Run 1 Trial A dogs then Trial B dogs, followed by Run 2 Trial A dogs then Trial B dogs.

Important additional information (Please read).

Ballot system

- Ballot will close 11 April.
- Once the draw has happened, everyone will receive an email advising if they are successful or unsuccessful.
- If successful you will need to complete your entry and pay by 15 April 5pm.
- Unpaid entries will be removed and a new ballot done to fill vacancies.
- Withdrawals will be allowed until 9am 21 April. No refunds after that date.
- Entries breaching the rules will be rejected from the ballot.
- No Dog can run in both Trial A and Trial B. If eligible, you may enter both but if drawn for trial A your entry will be excluded from the ballot for trial B.

- Entries limited to only two entries per person/showmanager account for the day. This restriction might be lifted if space permits.
- All dogs will run in the first round. Dogs that do not complete the course, will not be eligible to compete in the second round.
- Exhibitors to bring their dogs height card. Dogs without a card to be measured at check-in.
- Exhibitors need to arrange their own handlers.
- All handlers must be financial members of their state member body. Handlers must be over 16 years of age.
- Exhibitors should enter the name of their handler/helper in showmanager to aid with cataloguing.
- Bitches in season are not allowed to compete or allowed on the club grounds.
- Bitches must be a minimum of 10 weeks post whelp to compete. Mated bitches or bitches in whelp may not compete.
- The organisers reserve the right to make any changes to ensure the smooth conduct of the trial.
- The organisers reserve the right to accept or reject entries.
- This trial is run under the rules & regulations of Dogs ACT.
- Entries into Trial A are restricted to people living within the area identified below (110km from Canberra City) plus anyone living in the south coast area from Batemans Bay to Eden (includes Cooma to Bega) (the address listed in showmanager will be used to accept or reject entries).
