#### **Trial Details**

AM trial commences at 9.00am

PM trial commences after Masters finishes and following a short lunch break

Judges briefing for Masters – 8.40AM

Excellent- Birch, cypress and clove

#### **Entries and payment:**

Entries restricted to 20 dogs Masters per element/per class, Excellent restricted to 30 dogs per element/class.

Fees: \$17 per element/class

**Catalogues:** Available online from Show Manager and will be published on the Canberra Canine Noseworks Facebook page.

**Dogs ACT rep:** TBA

**Prizes:** 1<sup>st</sup> place, 2<sup>nd</sup> place, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place and ribbons for qualifying scores.

Presentations will commence after each element has been completed.

**Other:**

Competitors will need to submit one entry for each class/element. If you are running two dogs in the same class, then you will need to specify the second handler's name on your entry form. Competitors from the same household will run back-to-back.

It is the competitor's responsibility to only enter classes that they are eligible to enter. Refer to s6.1 Titling Classes and s6.2 Progression through the Titling Classes of the 'Rules' (specifically s6.2.2 and s6.2.3) for eligibility requirements.

Competitors should respect the primary school and not visit the venue prior to the trial or bring any scent onto the grounds. Many search locations are real-life environments and as such visiting these areas may risk contaminating the area or losing the opportunity to use the locations for future events.

There is a large green corridor adjacent to the venue which can be used to exercise your dogs and we would appreciate you using this space to toilet your dogs, please be mindful that on one side of the grounds is a residential area so please keep your dogs barking to a minimum and consider if your car needs screening to minimise any triggers.

No odour is to be brought or used at the trial by competitors on the day.

Competitors **must** park, crate and walk their dogs in designated area only. Please note that competitors not adhering to these rules may be asked to leave the grounds.

**For the safety of all competitors, please ensure that your dog is on lead at all times including leaving your vehicle. Only dogs who have entered the search area where an off-lead option is available are permitted to run off lead.**

No bitches on oestrus are permitted at the trial.

The club reserves the right to make any changes that will ensure the smooth conduct of the trial, including to substitute or appoint additional judges, to accept or reject entries and to adjust the starting times. Dogs ACT regulations allow contracted judges to compete in trials provided that they don't do so in the classes that they have been contracted to judge.

**COVID-19:** Please do not attend the trial if you or your dogs are unwell or have recently tested positive for COVID or any other infectious disease, we value our competitors, volunteers and canine companions, so please don't make them unwell.
