Entries decided by Ballot

Venue: ACT Companion Dog Club Grounds, Narrabundah Lane, Symonston.

Class: 100m Sprint.

Ballot closes 09.00am Tuesday 1 July 2025. **No Changes** or refunds on entries after 12 July 2025.

Entry fee: \$20.00 (includes a \$2 equipment fundraising levy).

Online entries only, via Showmanager (Registry dogs only)**

Part A (restricted) – entries capped at 30 dogs, restricted to people living within the area identified in the attached map **

Part B - entries capped at 30 dogs

Judge: Jess Buckley (ACT)

Lure Drivers: Helen Mosslar (ACT) and Belinda Mitchell (NSW)

This trial will be using a continuous lure and have an enclosed catching pen.

Check-in: 9.30 to 10.15am. Anyone not checked in will be marked absent.

Measuring Dogs: Owners will need to fill in the height card before presenting the dog for measurement. Blank height cards will be available on the day.

Vetting: There will be no vetting at check-in, but organisers reserve the right to vet any dog if it deems necessary.

Judging starts: 10.30am. Maybe be delayed due to frost or fog.

Run Order: Run 1 for Officials dogs, Part A dogs then Part B dogs, followed by Run 2 in the same order

Awards: Qualification Certificates and ribbons.

**Important additional information (Please read).

Ballot system

- Dogs must have their showmanager profile linked to the Dogs Aust registry to be entered.
- The Main Officials dogs are not included in the entry cap number.
- Ballot will close 1 July and be drawn.
- Once the draw has happened, everyone will receive an email advising if they are successful or unsuccessful. A maximum of 2 dogs will be allowed.
- If successful you will need to complete your entry and pay by 5th July.
- Unpaid entries will be removed and a new ballot done to fill vacancies.
- Withdrawals will be allowed until 9am 12 July. No refunds or changes after that date.
- Entries breaching the rules may be rejected from the ballot.



- All dogs will run in the first round. Dogs that do not complete the course, will not be eligible to compete in the second round.
- Exhibitors to bring their dogs height card. Dogs without a card to be measured at check-in.
- Exhibitors need to arrange their own handlers.
- All handlers must be financial members of their state member body. Handlers must be over 16 years of age.
- Exhibitors should enter the name of their handler/helper in showmanager to aid with cataloguing.
- Bitches in season are not allowed to compete or allowed on the club grounds.
- Bitches must be a minimum of 10 weeks post whelp to compete. Mated bitches or bitches in whelp may not compete.
- The organisers reserve the right to make any changes to ensure the smooth conduct of the trial.
- The organisers reserve the right to accept or reject entries.
- This trial is run under the rules & regulations of Dogs ACT.
- Entries into Part A are restricted to people living within the area identified below (110km from Canberra City) plus anyone living in the south coast area from Batemans Bay to Eden (includes Cooma to Bega) (the address listed in showmanger will be used to accept or reject entries).
