Entries decided by Ballot

Venue: Belconnen Dog Obedience Club grounds, Mitchell.

Class: 100m Sprint.

Ballot closes 09.00am Friday 24 October 2025. **No changes** or refunds on entries after 7 November 2025.

Entry fee: \$22.00.

Online entries only, via Showmanager (**Registry dogs only**)**
Entries capped at 60, not including the official's dogs.



Judge: Maelyn Draper (ACT)

Lure Drivers: Helen Mossler (ACT) and Belinda Mitchell (NSW)

This trial will be using a continuous lure and have an enclosed catching pen.

Check-in: 3.00 pm to 3.45 pm. Anyone not checked in will be marked absent.

Measuring Dogs: Owners will need to fill in the height card before presenting the dog for measurement. Blank height cards will be available on the day.

Vetting: There will be no vetting at check-in, but organisers reserve the right to vet any dog if it deems necessary. **Bitches in season are not allowed to compete or allowed on club grounds.**

Judging starts: 4.00 pm (may be delayed due to temperature).

Run Order: Run 1 for Officials dogs then all other dogs, followed by Run 2 in the same order.

Dogs attending the Dogs ACT shows who have not completed their 1st run before the completion of Run 1 is called, will be marked absent.

****Important additional information (Please read).**

Ballot system

- **Dogs must have their showmanager profile linked to the Dogs Aust registry to be entered.**
- The Main Officials dogs are not included in the entry cap number.
- Ballot will close 9am 24 October and be drawn.
- Once the draw has happened, everyone will receive an email advising if they are successful or unsuccessful. A maximum of 2 dogs will be allowed.
- If successful you will need to complete your entry and pay by 29th October.
- Unpaid entries will be removed and a new ballot done to fill vacancies.
- Withdrawals will be allowed until 5 pm 7th November 2025. No refunds or changes after that date.
- Entries breaching the rules may be rejected from the ballot.

- All dogs will run in the first round. Dogs that do not complete the course, will not be eligible to compete in the second round.
- Exhibitors to bring their dogs height card. Dogs without a card to be measured at check-in.
- Exhibitors need to arrange their own handlers.
- All handlers must be financial members of their state member body. Handlers must be over 16 years of age.
- Exhibitors should enter the name of their handler/helper in showmanager to aid with cataloguing.
- Bitches must be a minimum of 10 weeks post whelp to compete. Mated bitches or bitches in whelp may not compete.
- **The organisers reserve the right to make any changes to ensure the smooth conduct of the trial.**
- **The organisers reserve the right to accept or reject entries.**
- **This trial is run under the rules & regulations of Dogs ACT.**
