Applications for the 2026 tracking and track and search stewarding courses are now open.\*

Each course has a theory and a practical component and includes developing skills in:

1. Designing and accurately mapping tracks with limited supervision
2. Understanding rules relevant to the planning and running of tracks
3. Identifying safety risks and strategies for mitigating those risks
4. Planning and managing the logistics of a trial to ensure smooth and efficient set out and running of tracks.

**Track and search stewards course:** Theory A 18 February 6:30-8:30pm, Theory B (combined with tracking) 4 March 6:30-8:30pm. Practical 28 March 8:30am-12:30pm.

**Tracking stewards course:** Theory A 25 February 6:30-8:30pm, Theory B (combined with track and search) 4 March 6:30-8:30pm. Practical 21 March 8:30am-12:30pm.
