TRIAL DETAILS

- Online entries only – Ultimate \$20 non-members, \$15 members. All other classes \$17 non-members, \$12 members available at <https://showmanager.com.au>
- The Spectacular is made up of 3 individual trials across 3 separate days. This means you can enter each ultimate on each day.
- Running order will be provided at the event and on Canberra Scent Sport Club and Canberra Canine Nosework Facebook sites.
- Commences 9am. Check-in is self Check in and will be available from 8.15am
- A separate entry form must be submitted for each entry (Scent Work Rules s8.1.2)
- Competitors must only enter the classes they are eligible for (s6.1 and s6.2).
- No upgrades will be allowed after the trial closing date.
- Only one dog/handler per Class. An owner entering two dogs in the same Class must advise the name of a second handler (who is current and financial with a member body). Dogs from the same family will run concurrently.
- Competitors should not visit the trial location prior to the trial date.
- Canberra Scent Sport Club reserves the right to make any changes that will ensure the smooth conduct of the trial, to substitute or appoint additional judges and to accept or reject entries.
- No target odour to be brought to the grounds. No scent work training on the grounds during the trial.
- Bitches in oestrus may NOT be trialled. Bitches may be vetted.

- High in Trial (Novice, Advanced, Excellent, Masters, Ultimate): Rosette

STEWARDS

All competitors who help to steward will be guaranteed entry into the trial to say thank you for your help.]

Balloting of entries:

- If you have entered your dog in 4 elements (ie. novice - containers, vehicles, interiors and exteriors) your exhibit number will be placed in a hat (except for those competitors who have volunteered to steward).
- Numbers will be drawn out and recorded in order until the required number is reached.
- You will be notified by email that you have been balloted out of 1 element.
- Each competitor will only be balloted out of 1 element max.
- Your exhibitor number will then be placed at the bottom of the catalogue in the order you were drawn in the ballot.
- On the day of the trial, at the close of check-in, if there are absentees, handlers who have been balloted out will be offered a run in that element, in the order they were drawn in the ballot.
- If your dog is not offered a run, your will be given a cash refund on the day.
